

CASE STUDY – Gilabbey Veterinary Hospital, Cork, Ireland



Annual Savings: €3000 Payback: 22 Months

The Client:

Founded in 1957 Gilabbey Veterinary Hospital has a fabulous 8,000 sq. ft purpose designed facility at Vicars Road, Cork. It is a dedicated small animal veterinary hospital and a recognised training centre for veterinary nurses. The diverse needs of the hospital demand custom lighting including waiting room, laboratories, isolation units, theatre and radiology rooms.

The Project:

GVH recognised the need to reduce their energy consumption and cut operating costs to offer attractive pricing to their customers. Energy Sense Ireland worked closely with Shane Guerin and his staff to identify rapid savings. On lighting alone 40% savings was calculated. **Save It Easy®** was installed to upgrade over 200 lamps to low energy lighting without any disruption to the everyday business of GVH.

The Savings:

As a result of installing the **Save It Easy®** units, annual energy cost saving of €3000 and CO2 emissions savings of 21.5 tones have been made. This installation was a full facility retrofit with energy savings of 40% on lighting.

Project Payback and Comments:
